Minimum Wages Revisions

Tripura Minimum Wages Notification

Government of Tripura vide notification No. F.87(30)-LAB/ENF/MW/SHOPS/2002(A)/7066-84, has released minimum wage for the State of Tripura effective from 1st October 2021. Please refer the table below for revised minimum wages and also the notification appended herewith for detailed information.

Notifications/Circulars/Amendments

Linking of ESIC's Insurance Number with EPFO's Universal Account Number

ESIC vide circular dated 9th December, 2021 has decided to link ESIC insurance number of insured person with the EPFO's Universal Account Number (UAN) which a 12 digit identification number number allotted by EPFO. Therefore, members of EPFO with authorized Aadhaar and Bank details seeded against the UAN can submit their provident fund withdrawal or settlement or transfer requests. An arrangement has been made in the ESI portal where the employer can enter the UAN of IPs through the module. After entering details in the system the same can be verified with EPFO. Please refer the circular appended herewith for more details.

Enforcement of provisions towards ESIC in the State of Assam

ESIC vide notification S.O. 5371(E) has implemented the provisions of the following Chapters in the entire area of districts in the State of Assam such as Barpeta, Bongaigaon, Bishwanath, Cachar, Chirang, Darrang, Dhemaji, Dhubri, Golaghat, Goalpara, Lakhimpur, Majuli, Nalbari, Marigaon, Nagaon, Sibsagar, Udalguri, West Karbi Anglong (in addition to the already implemented area in the district), including Karbi Anglong, Karimganj, South Salmara Mankachar.

- Chapter IV on Contribution,
- Chapter V on Benefits and
- Chapter VI on Adjudication of Disputes and Claims.

The Assam Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation (Amendment) Act, 2021

Government of Assam vide notification No. LGL.55/2005/46 has amended the provisions towards liability of tax, returns and included new provisions towards applicability of the provisions on Assam Value Added Tax and automated data processing system. Following are the salient features of the amendment:

1. Apply liability to tax on members of the armed forces of India,
2. The penalty for not filing return has increased to one hundred for each day of delay or a maximum of rupees five thousand whichever is less,
3. The employers who are previously registered under The Assam Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017, The Assam Value Added Tax Act, 2003, The Assam Taxation (On Specified Lands) Act, 1990, The Assam Agricultural Income-tax Act, 1939, The Assam Electricity Duty Act, 1964 considered to be registered under this enactment,
4. The Assam Value Added Tax Act, 2003 is applicable as is without any change,
5. Introduction of procedures for e-filing of returns and e-payment of taxes and automated data processing system.

NOTIFICATION

In continuation of this Department's Notification No.F.87(30)-LAB/ENF/MW/SHOPS/ 2002(A)/1388-98 dated 21st June, 2021 and in furtherance of the aforesaid Notification, the State Government hereby revises the Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) on the basis of 6-monthly average Consumer Price Index Numbers for the period commencing from 01-01-2021 and ending on 30-06-2021. The half yearly average Consumer Price Index is **99 point** for different categories of workers engaged in the employment of **"Shops and Establishments"** in Tripura. The Variable Dearness Allowance shall be payable with effect from **01-10-2021** by the employers to the workers/employees employed in the aforesaid employment as per the following schedule :

**THE ASSAM PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS
AND EMPLOYMENTS TAXATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2021**

AN ACT

further to amend the Assam Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation Act, 1947.

Preamble

Whereas, it is expedient to amend the Assam Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation Act, 1947, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Assam Act No. VI

It is hereby enacted in the Seventy-second Year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

Short title,
extent and
commencement

1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation (Amendment) Act, 2021.
- (2) It shall have the like extent as the principal Act.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of
section 3

2. In the principal Act, in section 3, after the third proviso, the following explanation shall be inserted, namely:-

“Explanation. The words ‘members of the Armed Forces of India’ in the second proviso of section 3 means the persons who are subject to the Army Act, 1950, the Navy Act, 1957 or the Air Force Act, 1950 and are serving/posted in any part of the State of Assam.”

new section 5B

3. In the principal Act, after section 5A, the following new section 5B shall be inserted, namely:-

“Deemed Registration 5B. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 5A of the Act, any person or employer who is already registered under the Assam Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017, the Assam Value Added Tax Act, 2003, the Assam Taxation (On Specified Lands) Act, 1990, the Assam Agricultural Income Tax Act, 1939 and the Assam Electricity Duty Act, 1964, shall be deemed to have been registered or enrolled as the case may be under this Act and such person or employer shall be liable to make payment of tax and also liable to furnish return as per provisions of this Act:

Provided that State Government may by notification published in the Official Gazette extend application of the provision to any other State Act.”

4. In the principal Act, in sub-section 3, of section 7, for the words, “rupees five for each day of delay”, the words “rupees one-hundred for each day of delay or a maximum of rupees five thousand only, whichever is less”, shall be substituted.

5. In the principal Act, after section 18, the following new sections shall be inserted, namely :-

“Applicability

18A. Subject to the provisions of this Act and the rules made thereunder, the provisions of the Assam Value Added Tax Act, 2003 and the rules, orders or notifications made or issued thereunder relating to amendment, cancellation and suspension of registration; retention of accounts, requirement to provide information, transfer of liability of any firm or Hindu undivided family to pay tax in the event of dissolution of such firm or partition of such family, inspection, search and seizure, power to call for information, bar to certain proceedings, indemnity, treatment of documents furnished by person as confidential and other matters for which no specific provision has been made in this Act and the rules made thereunder, shall *mutatis mutandis* apply, to a person liable to pay tax under this Act or an employer responsible for deduction of tax under this Act, as if those provisions were *mutatis mutandis* incorporated in this Act and the rules framed and orders and notification issued under those provisions were *mutatis mutandis* framed or issued under the relevant provisions so incorporated under this Act.”

“Automation

18B. (1) The Government shall introduce and establish an automated data processing system for complementing the purposes of this Act and for matters incidental and allied thereto.

(2) The Government may from time to time make Regulations for regulating the interactions between the person and the authorities appointed or constituted under this Act.

(3) The provisions contained in the Information and Technology Act, 2000, and the rules made thereunder and directions given under the Act, including the provisions relating to digital signatures, electronic records, electronic governance, attribution,

acknowledgement and dispatch of electronic records, securing electronic records and securing digital signatures and digital signature certificates, shall so far as they apply to the procedures shall apply under this Act.

- (4) Except as may be provided otherwise in this Act, the software for the automated data processing system, the operating system, the operating instructions and the criteria for any selection shall be treated as confidential.
- (5) The Commissioner of Taxes may, by notification in the Official Gazette, with the prior approval of Government, prescribe procedures for e-filing of returns and e-payment of taxes.”
